Galway City Council (GCC) is submitting the enclosed Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement for the BusConnects Galway: Cross City-Link (University Road to Dublin Road) Scheme to An Bord Pleanála and is hereby applying for approval under Section 51 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, for the purposes of construction and operation of the BusConnects Galway: Cross City Link (University Road to Dublin Road) Scheme for the purposes of facilitating public transport.

The BusConnects Galway: Cross-City Link (University Road to Dublin Road) Scheme consists of the construction of bus, cycle and pedestrian infrastructure. The scheme has an overall length of approximately 6.7km, and is routed along the University Road, St. Vincent's Avenue, St. Francis Street, Eglinton Street, Eyre Square, Forster Street, College Road and Dublin Road and also encompasses numerous roads within the city centre including Fairgreen Road, Bothar Uí Eithir, Prospect Hill, Bothar na mBan, St. Brendan's Avenue, Headford Road, Dyke Road, Woodquay, Daly's Place, Merchants Road, Forthill Street, Queen Street and Dock Road, all in the County of Galway and within Galway City Council (GCC) administrative areas.

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report has been prepared and compiled in accordance with the provisions of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, and in accordance with Directive 2011/92/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 December 2011 as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 in respect of the proposed road development. A Natura Impact Statement has also been prepared in respect of the proposed road development.
