in accordance with Section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), White Hill Wind Limited gives notice of its intention to make an application to An Bord Pleanála for a ten-year permission in relation to posed development in the townlands of Ridge, Knocknabranagh and agh, and Agharue, Co. Carlow; and Coolcullen, Cloneen and Coan East, Co. Kilkenny; as follow

- 162 metres and an overall tip height of 185 met All associated turbine foundations and crane hardstanding areas
- All associated underground electrical and communications cabling: Construction of Internal wind farm access tracks Construction of a site entrance from the L3037 local road and upgrades to 2 no. existing agricultural entrances from the L7122
- VI. 1 no. guy-wired meteorological mast with an overall height of 30
- VII. 1 no, temporary construction compound; Vill. 3 no. borrow pits which, when exhausted, will be utilised to
- manently store excess excavated material IX. The storage, as required, of excavated material at 2 no. further
- dedicated spoil deposition areas; X. Change of use of existing residential dwelling to wind farm site office;
 XI. Felling of 15 hectares of commercial forestry plantation to facilitate
- the construction of wind farm infrastructure;
