To whom this may concern,

My home has mica and after a very wet winter there has been quite considerable deterioration of the exterior building. (Please see attached photographs). I thought I had found the perfect place away from noise and pollution as one of my family members has Autism and two have Asthma.

Our home is in close proximity of the proposed twenty five year working quarry and the noise and the drilling will be problematic as my autistic family member has Sensory Auditory difficulties.

It will take many years for our home to be demolished and re-built because of the high number of mica homes in Donegal.

I do not have mains water but we have a very good water well and the possibility of the quality and supply of the water is very concerning due to the drilling and blasting of this proposed quarry.

One of my close neighbours has scaffolding around his mica home for the past three years trying to hold the exterior together and he has no idea when demolition and building will begin.

A short distance from my home there is a Council housing estate called Castle Grove with thirty four Tusla houses a Tusla Family support unit and a Respond Special needs residential unit all with mica.

In all Raphoe has thirty seven houses, a special needs residential unit and a family resource centre with mica and all within close vicinity of the proposed quarry.

Raphoe is a Heritage Town which attracts visitors and tourists, a twenty five year working quarry in the heart of this town would be detrimental to the local economy.

Todate there has not been a planning permission sign on the R236. I pass the entrance of the proposed quarry daily and is checked daily also by concerned members of our community.




