To whom this may concern,

My home is a two minute walk to the entrance of the road leading to the proposed quarry in Raphoe. I pass this road two to three daily whilst walking my dog and to date I have never at any time seen a planning permission notice regarding the reopening of the quarry.

Raphoe is a Heritage town and we welcome visitors. Having a working quarry in the middle of the town will undoubtedly affect tourism and local businesses. Oakfield Park which is one of the main attractions to Raphoe is very close to the proposed quarry.

There is a Secondary school a very short distance from the proposed quarry and the noise and health implication for the pupils are very concerning.

Unfortunately as with the rest of Donegal we have a large number of mica homes and most of these are built in close proximity to the proposed quarry. I know that many of these home owners are extremely worried about safety for their families living in a mica home as it is at present and the implications of what the possible drilling and blasting will do to their homes if the quarry was allowed to reopen.

We have an abundance of rock in rural parts of this County where there are no homes or businesses and blasting and drilling will do no harm to homes, health and local economy.
