

**APPLICATION TO

I, Patrick Connolly of Scotshouse Quarries Limited, intend to apply for Substitute Consent for development at this site in the townland of Aghnaskew, in the Barony of Dartree (Dartree By), Scotshouse, County Monaghan (ITM 649474 818324).

The development consists of quarrying, including rock extraction by blasting and processing activities, over an area of 5.6 hectares of land adjoining an existing quarry, and restoration to agricultural grassland using site won materials which has been stored in berms onsite.

The application is accompanied by a remedial Environmental Impact Assessment Report (rEIAR).

Submissions or observations may be made on the application, to An Bord Pleanála, Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, without charge. Submissions of observations must be in writing and made within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt of the application by An Bord Pleanála and such submissions and observations will be considered by An Bord Pleanála in making a decision on the application. An Bord Pleanála may grant the consent subject to or without conditions, or may refuse to grant it.

The application for consent may be inspected, or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, or the relevant planning authority during its public opening hours.
