

Hughes Planning and Development Consultants, 85 Merrion Square, Dublin 2 have been instructed by our client, Kealy's of Cloghran, Swords Road, Cloghran, Co. Dublin, to make a submission in relation to the submission dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2023 from the National Transport Authority (NTA) which was prepared in relation to the subject scheme.

We would state, in response to Section 2.7.11 of the NTA's submission, that our client retains their initially expressed concerns in relation to the creation of a traffic hazard, the removal of on-site parking areas, reduced accessibility of the rear carpark, commercial impact during the construction and operational phase of the subject scheme and the scheme's incompliance with policies contained within the Fingal Development Plan 2023-2029. These issues are of direct concern to our client who fears the devaluation of their property due to the delivery of the subject scheme.

Due to the fact that the parking area to the rear of the premises is rented under licence from the Dublin Airport Authority on five-year lease agreements, with our client having no security of tenure on this carpark long-term, the loss of the front parking area is of key concern to our client with the subject premises almost entirely dependent on customers arriving by car and coach.

Notwithstanding this key concern, our client's primary concern relates to the negative impact of the subject scheme, during its construction phase, on the unobstructed operation of their premises which employs 56 no. staff. In this regard, definitive clarity is required on the timeline for works on the wider road section immediately forward of the subject premises and extending to the Airport Roundabout. Should works within this area be prolonged, this will result in a significant and negative impact to the operation of our client's premises.

It is considered, for the reasoning presented in our client's initial submission, that the subject scheme will be detrimental to the residential amenity of our client's property and will unduly compromise the value of this property.

In this regard, we would herein confirm our client's willingness to engage with the National Transport Authority (NTA) to identify suitable mitigation measures to ensure the adequate protection of the commercial business in operation at this location. In the absence of comprehensive mitigation measures, it is considered reasonable that appropriate compensation be afforded to our client.

We trust that the Board will have regard to the contents of our original submission, as is included in Appendix B of this submission, and we await a favourable outcome in due course.

We trust the enclosed is satisfactory and we would be very much obliged if you could provide confirmation of the receipt of this submission at your earliest convenience.
