I refer to your attached correspondence dated 28th May 2024 requesting comments from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to assist An Bord Pleanála in determining whether an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is required for the above development.

The Agency has not received a licence application relating to the development described above.

The planning documentation includes correspondence dated 18th January 2022 from the Agency where it determined that a Waste Facility Permit would be required based on the information provided. See Appendix 1.2 of the EIAR (Article 11 No: 2643). This was in response to a request for a Article 11 determination on whether a Waste Licence, Waste Facility Permit, or Certificate of Registration Application was required for the activity.


