Planning Application Reference No. PD/22/526 has been received by Roscommon County Council.

Applicant: Eamon Harney

Application: Permission for development consisting of the extraction of sand, stone and gravel (site area 6.938 hectares) The development will involve the extraction of sand, stone and gravel over an extraction area of 4.90 hectares (volume to be extracted = 466.766m³ approximately) over a 10 year period, screening/processing of stone, sand and gravel from the site using mobile plant, construction of offices (33m²), welfare facilities (9m²), well, water settlement pond (area 2,020 m²), weighbridge, wheel wash, entrance, set down area, car parking, truck parking, refuelling pad, petrol oil interceptor, fencing, landscaping/screening, signage, lighting, wastewater storage, tank for site offices, and all other ancillary works. (The land will be restored to agricultural lands on the completion of the extraction of sand, stone and gravel) (An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) has been submitted with the planning application) at Rooskagh Townland, Bellanamullia (Bealnamulla), Athlone, Co. Roscommon.
