On behalf of our client FuturEnergy Carrownagowan DAC (applicant) please find enclosed a planning application for the construction of a 110kV underground grid connection cable connecting the permitted Carrownagowan wind farm (ABP-308799-20) to the existing 110kV substation at Ardnacrusha. The grid connection was not applied for as part of the recently granted Carrownagowan Wind Farm planning application.

The planning application follows from the pre-application consultation with An Bord Pleanála (ABP-314127-22) regarding whether or not the proposed 110kV grid connection constitutes strategic infrastructure development, as defined in the Planning and Development Act (as amended). Having considered the proposal, An Bord Pleanála determined that the proposed development falls within the scope of section 182A of the Act, and that a planning application should be made directly to the board.
