Grants to a maximum of €2,500 for works of routine maintenance and minor repairs.

Historic Structures Fund 2024

The Historic Structures Fund offers grant funding under the following streams

- · Stream 1 €15,000 up to €50,000
- Stream 1 Historic Shopfronts sub-stream €15,000 up to €50,000
- Stream 2 €50,000 up to €200,000
- Vernacular Structures Stream (structures with no legal protection) €5,000 up to €10,000

Applications in respect of an individual structure can be made to both schemes, but funding will only be awarded from one scheme in any one year. Applicants cannot avail of funding under both the Historic Structures Fund and the Built Heritage Investment Scheme in the same year.

Applicants must ensure application forms and checklists are completed for submission.
