Graphic Representation of Tree Form, Balance and Protection Zone

Canopy Extent  
Cardinal Radii  
Stem Circumference  
Root Protection Area (RPA)  
Canopy is drawn to account for any natural asymmetry or imbalance. Crown Representation is scaled to account for north, east, west and south radii.  
Root Protection Area (RPA)  
This area relates the "RPA" radius as defined in the Tree Survey Table and is measured from the tree centre. This area defines the preliminary Construction Exclusion Zone (CEZ) that must be protected by fencing from the potentially damaging effects of construction activity.

Tree Quality (Categorisation)

- Category "A" Trees (Green Button) Excellent Quality Trees
- Category "B" Trees (Blue Button) Good Quality Trees
- Category "C" Trees (Grey Button) Mediocre to Poor Quality Trees
- Category "U" Trees (Red Button) Dead, Dying or Otherwise Compromised Trees that are Unsustainable.
- Hedges
- Scrub and Thicket

Tree Retention and Loss

- Trees Intended for Retention - Solid Green Crown Outline
- Trees Intended for Removal In Conjunction With Development Works - Broken Pink Crown Outline
