I am writing in connection with the above case number and proposed planning permission for a large development close to The Hastings Estate in Balbriggan.

I previously submitted an observation to Fingal County Council in relation to this planning request.

I would like to point out my own personal reasons for objection:

- 1. The planned walkway access which is proposed between the development and The Hastings is unwelcomed and unwarranted. The residents of the estate and I personally feel very strong against this access being provided. It will take away our privacy giving more people the freedom to pass by our windows to access the new development. It will encourage antisocial behaviour and make it an easy escape route to evade the Gardai.
- 2. Providing this access will also take away valuable space in our estate which is already a luxury and we do not have enough car parking spaces as it is currently.
- 3. While I acknowledge there is a serious lack of homes in Balbriggan and they are urgently needed, infrastructure and services need to be invested in first. There is a clear lack of services in Balbriggan currently (GP's, Dentists). Neither of these I am able to avail of in Balbriggan.

Our resident association has put in an observation also and we have had many meetings with local groups and businesses regarding this development and there are serious concerns should this go ahead.

I would kindly request that An Bord Pleanala to take on board the concerns raised by all observations submitted and give serious thoughts to any permission granted.
