Desktop records were sourced from the following locations:

- National Biodiversity Data Centre (NBDC); and
- National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) data request.

For the NBDC, data were compiled for the grid squares overlapping the Main Wind Farm site (10 km grid square N66) and Cable Corridor in areas outside the road network (2 km grid square N66P), which also overlapped with the Proposed Substation. For the NRWS data request, the optioned lands shapefile was used to query all hectads that intersected with a 5 km buffer that surrounded the optioned lands.

Data were downloaded from NBDC on 15/08/2023 and a data request from NPWS was received on 29/06/2023.

All records are shown, regardless of age.

#### 1.0 Flora

Rare, threatened and invasive flora are listed below in Table A-1 and Table A-2. There were two records of rare or threatened flora within the Main Wind Farmand Cable Corridor. There were two records of invasive plant species at the Main Wind Farm but none at the Cable Corridor.
