Clare.

Dear Sir/Madam,

On behalf of our client, FuturEnergy Knockshanvo Designated Activity Company, please find enclosed a copy of a planning application for development of a grid connection which will facilitate the connection of the proposed 9 no. wind turbine Knockshanvo Wind Farm to the national electricity grid. The proposed development will comprise 110kV underground cabling to Ardnacrusha 110kV electrical substation and associated works in in the townlands of Lakyle, Knockdonagh, Castlebank, Cloghera, Roo West, Drumsillagh or Sallybank (Merritt), Glenlon South, Trough, Drumsillagh or Sallybank (Parker) and Ballykeelaun, Co. Clare.

The application is being made directly to An Bord Pleanála as Strategic Infrastructure Development (SID) under the provisions of Section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. This position was confirmed by An Bord Pleanála to the applicant in correspondence dated the 18th January 2024 following pre-application consultations with the Board (ref: ABP-317763-23). A copy of that correspondence is included in the application pack.

Proposed Grid Connection Description

A description of the Proposed Grid Connection as set out in the public planning notices, is as follows:

The proposed development will consist of the provision of the following:

- *I.* The provision of underground electrical cabling (110kV) from the proposed Knockshanvo Wind Farm development to the existing Ardnacrusha 110kV electrical substation to facilitate the connection to the national grid;
- *II. Provision of 14 joint bays, communication chambers and earth sheath links along the proposed underground electrical cabling route;*
- *III.* Permanent and temporary Site Drainage;
- *IV.* Ancillary forestry felling to facilitate construction and operation of the proposed development;
- V. Reinstatement of land, road and track surface above the proposed cabling trench;
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An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and Natura Impact Statement (NIS) have been prepared in relation to the project and accompany this planning application.

As outlined in detail in the accompanying documentation, all elements of the Proposed Development, i.e. the Proposed Grid Connection (subject of this Section 182A application) and the Proposed Wind Farm (subject of a separate Section 37A application), have been assessed as part of the EIAR and NIS lodged.

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An electronic copy of the planning application pack as outlined above is enclosed with this letter. An Bord Pleanála, Clare County Council and Limerick County Council have received a copy of the application pack. The application will be available for inspection at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, Clare County Council and Limerick City and County Council for a period of seven weeks commencing on the 12th September 2024.
