On behalf of our Client, Cummeennabuddoge Wind Designated Activity Company, we hereby give notice of our intention to make an application to An Bord Pleanála for permission for the development of Cummeennabuddoge Wind Farm in the townlands of Cummeennabuddoge (County Kerry), Clydaghröe (County Kerry), Glashacormick (County Kerry), Cummeenavrick (County Kerry), and Caherdowney (County Cork).

This Planning Application follows on from the submission of a pre-application request to An Bord Pleanála by Cummeennabuddoge Wind Designated Activity Company, which confirmed that the development constitutes an SID (ABP 319219-24). A copy of the SID pre-application determination letter is enclosed with this application.

Payment of the application fee of €100,000 has been made by EFT on 16/07/2024.
