

A Chara,

I would like to strongly object to the planning application Ref No: 2460411 submitted by EDF Renewables Ireland Limited, which seeks to erect 7 x 180m high Wind turbines. I have great concerns for both my family and the community of Broadford/Kilbane and surrounding area. Our whole village will be surrounded by 180M meter plus Turbines, that no family should have to live close to. Looking at the application I will be within a few Kilometres of numerous turbines.

Also to note other applications have been submitted by other Energy companies to erect wind turbines in the area, with a possible 60/70 turbines in the local area.

See some of the below concerns that I would like to raise

# Health risk to family

- Mental Health: From the constant audio and non-audible sounds that is generated from wind turbines 24/7 I feel it will have an impact on my mental health, as it stands I am very lite sleeper and constant 'Whooshing' noise along with the infrasound will have negative impact on both my family and I. As the sun sets in the evening my house will be exposed to constant flickering, which will become a nuisance and frustration.
- Contaminated water: We have a private well, the construction of these Turbines have the potential to contaminate our drinking water.

# **Destruction of Natural Bogs**

I know there are natural bog located on the proposed sites. In the event of these constructed the entire Bog within this area will be uplifted and be replaced by both steel and concrete. My two

concerns are; firstly I was under the impression that Bogs were to be protected and secondly will leave us at risk to potential land slides, which has recently occurred in Meenbog Co Donegal. The amount of rainfall in recent years and the possibility of increased rain in the coming years due to Climate change will enhance the risk of landslides.

# Flora and Fauna

Currently we are blessed to share our local lands with a large range of Flora and Fauna. We have numerous protected species in the area such as horseshoe bats and hen harriers. Having this wind turbines in the area will have the potential to kill or scare off numerous species of animals in the area, including wiping out their territories.

# Road traffic

On the roads around Bridgetown, Broadford and surrounding roads we have a lot of HGV vehicles on the road as is, on account of the multiple quarries in the surrounding areas. The current Roads can barely cater for current traffic volumes. The roads are in bad condition at the best of times, having all this additional traffic on the road will deteriorate even further making it undrivable, therefore adding additional time on my daily commute.
