Galway City Council (GCC) is submitting the enclosed Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement for the BusConnects Galway: Dublin Road Development to An Bord Pleanála and is hereby applying for approval under Section 51 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, for the purpose of construction and operation of the BusConnects Galway: Dublin Road Development for the propose of facilitating walking, cycling and public transport.

The BusConnects Galway: Dublin Road Development consists of the construction of Pedestrian, Cyclist and Public Transport infrastructure. The development has an overall length of 3.9km and the route runs along the Dublin Road within GCC's administrative area.

An Appropriate Assessment & Natura Impact Statement has also been prepared in respect of the proposed road development.
