On behalf of Laois County Council (LCC), RPS Group Limited (RPS) hereby submits a planning application for approval to An Bord Pleanála (ABP) under Sections¹ 175 and 177AE of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended (the Planning Act), and the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2025, as amended (the Planning Regulations) for the proposed **Clonaslee Flood Relief Scheme**.

The proposed scheme will consist of flood relief works along, adjacent to, and in the vicinity of the Clodiagh River, in the townlands of Brittas, Bunastick, Clonaslee, Ballynakill and Brockagh, in County Laois, within LCC's administrative boundary.

The statutory public notices and the plans and particulars submitted with this application, including a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR), provide details of the proposed works.
