Ryan Hanley Consulting Engineers were appointed by Limerick City & County Council (LCCC) as Engineering and Environmental consultants to prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment Report for the proposed University of Limerick to National Technology Park cycle path project (UL to NTP cycle path). Following initial information gathering and surveys a number of route options were considered and a preferred option identified. The design of the preferred route option is constraints-led, with a view to minimising environmental impacts.

In keeping with legal requirements and the EPA guidelines, the project team would appreciate any views or comments that you may have in relation to the scope of the environmental impact assessment of the proposed UL to NTP cycle path, as set out in the enclosed EIA Scoping Report.
