



Location of Quarry – extent and context.




Site Plan

Receptor View Locations: 1 - 4



1. A little bit above the western corner of the proposed quarry – it would be seen from here, but obscured by the biodiversity corridor.



3. Between the two entrances of the existing quarry and the one to be expanded, southeast of the site – the area to be seen will remain similar, except for the additional fence along the road to the quarry to be expanded.



2. Parallel to the site on the road leading there, looking north – the green strip will be visible.



4. Next to the Issert Kelly Old Graveyard on the road leading to the northeast to the entrance of the quarry – only the trees around it can be seen.

Receptor View Locations: 5 - 8



5. Southeast, opposite the quarry site – only the tree tops of the corridor are visible from this location.



7. Southeast of the quarry, looking northwest- nothing of the site can be seen from here.



6. East of the quarry, following the road - maximum the five-meter corridor may be viewed.



8. South of the proposed quarry, next to the Isert Kelly Castle – the trees will be visible from this position.

Receptor View Locations: 9 - 11



9. Northwest of the site, right next to the nearest residential buildings in that direction – none of the quarry may be seen.



11. Immediately after the forest at Grannagh Beg, following the road, the quarry is directly accessible – nothing may be seen from this location.



10. Following the road west of the quarry to the north – the corridor can be viewed.



12. North of the site, at the buildings closest in that direction – because of the hill, nothing will be visible.

Receptor View Locations: 13 - 14



13. On the street at Monksfield, looking southeast – the quarry can not be viewed.



14. Northeast of the site - nothing of it can be seen.
