Grid Reference (ITM): 712045:760412 Elevation: 78m AOD Distance from application area boundary: 510m Direction of View: North Date/time of photograph: 24/04/24 @ 14:30 Description: Parts of the northern field and the northern end of the two southern fields associated with the application area, are visible from a 200m long stretch of this local road, north of the R122. Most of the application area, including the access road, are screened by topography and vegetation. Parts of the works associated with the early and the final stages of the proposed development (i.e. Phase 1, start of Phase 2 and end of Phase 3 extraction and restoration) will be visible, while the majority of the works within Phased 2 and 3 will be screened by intervening topography. There are no properties along this section of road, which is infrequently used. None of the properties further north along this road experience views towards the application area, due to abundant screening vegetation.

Viewpoint D: Local road just north of the junction with the R122, approximately 1.3km southwest of the centre of Naul village.

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Viewpoint E: R122 - Regional Road, approximately 2.1km southwest of the centre of Naul village.

Description: The ridgeline above the application area is visible from a number of locations along the R122 to the west of Viewpoint B along the R122. However, the application area itself is fully screened by intervening vegetation in all views from this part of the R122 and in views from locations to the southwest in general.

Description: The application area is fully screened by intervening vegetation, structures and topography from within Naul village, such as this view from an elevated position within the graveyard. The northern end of the field within which the extraction area will be located can be glimpsed through a gap in the vegetation, but the works will be screened. The existing permitted Kilsaran concrete plant, east of the R108 can be glimpsed from a small number of locations within the village, but is viusally separated from the proposed development. While some HGVs will be visible traveling from the site entrance to the existing Kilsaran site along the R108, the number of HGVs traveling through Naul village will be reduced, as material will not have to be imported from other extraction sites, for the

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
