A Chara,

Údarás na Gaeltachta wishes to express its strong support for the proposed N6 Ring Road for Galway city, which we consider to be critical infrastructure for the sustainable economic, cultural, and social development of the South Connemara Gaeltacht.

The Galway Gaeltacht is the largest Gaeltacht in the country, with 53,459 residents (Census 2022) – equivalent to 51% of the total Gaeltacht population nationwide. Údarás na Gaeltachta currently supports 302 client companies in the South Connemara Gaeltacht alone, which provide 2,863 full-time jobs. Our 20 largest companies account for 2,260 of these positions, demonstrating their importance as economic anchors for the region.

In 2024, our client companies across the Gaeltacht achieved sales of €1.098 billion – an increase of 4.4% from 2023 and 28% growth over the past decade. Export sales reached €658 million, demonstrating the international scope and potential of these enterprises. However, despite this impressive performance, our client companies in South Connemara operate at a disadvantage due to infrastructure deficiencies.

The current situation is not sustainable:

- The Quincentenary Bridge, the only major transport bridge across the Corrib, is far beyond its designed capacity
- There are persistent traffic delays, which affect business operations
- Travel times between the east side of Galway and South Connemara are excessively long
- The closure of Galway Airport in October 2011 contributed to reduced access to the region
- Access to Ros an Mhíl port, a critical maritime location, is severely constrained

These infrastructure deficiencies now pose a threat to the sustainable development of the Gaeltacht region.



The development of the N6 Ring Road would deliver multiple strategic benefits:

1. Enhanced Business Competitiveness

- o Improved access to national and international markets for exported products
- o More efficient supply chains for raw materials and finished goods o Better connections to ports, airports, and the national motorway network
- o Expanded labour market, particularly for specialised skills available in eastern Galway
- o New opportunities for business collaboration across the region

2. Innovation and Technology Advancement

- o Support for high-technology companies such as Mylan, Freudenberg Medical, Aran Biomedical, ÉireComposites, and Telegael
- o Enhanced viability of our award-winning companies that have secured funding from the Disruptive Technologies Innovation Fund
- o Accelerated growth of our gteic digital hub network, which fosters innovation, creativity, and remote working capabilities

3. Marine Economy Development

- o Critical infrastructure support for Páirc na Mara in Cill Chiaráin (70km west of Galway city)
- o Enhanced connectivity for marine innovation services and businesses
- o Improved access to the strategic port at Ros an Mhíl
- o Support for sustainable growth in aquaculture, marine biotechnology, and marine energy

4. Tourism Growth

- o Improved access for the 200,000+ annual visitors to Connemara and Árainn o Support for the Connemara and Árainn Gaelic Coast initiatives
- o Enhanced visitor dispersal across western County Galway
- o Reduction in traffic congestion that currently deters tourists

5. Environmental and Sustainability Benefits

- Enabling expanded public transport services to South Connemara
- Reduced carbon emissions through decreased congestion and more efficient journey patterns
- Supporting population retention in Gaeltacht communities
- Preserving social and cultural networks that sustain the Irish language

As an organisation mandated to strengthen and preserve Irish as the primary means of communication in Gaeltacht communities, we recognise that economic vitality cannot be separated from cultural sustainability. Our research shows that 58% of those employed in Údarás client companies speak Irish, with particularly strong language usage in the media sector.

The N6 Ring Road is not just transport infrastructure – it is a lifeline that will enable Gaeltacht communities to achieve economic success while maintaining their distinctive cultural identity in the 21st century.

The N6 Ring Road represents essential infrastructure that would fundamentally enhance the viability and attractiveness of the Gaeltacht region in terms of investment, employment, tourism, and quality of life. After careful analysis of its impacts, we are of the firm and considered opinion that the development of this bypass is not simply beneficial but essential for the sustainable future of the Gaeltacht.

A Chara,

Is mian le hÚdarás na Gaeltachta a thacaíocht láidir a chur in iúl don Chuarbhóthar N6 atá beartaithe do chathair na Gaillimhe, a mheasann muid a bheith mar bhonneagar ríthábhachtach d'fhorbairt inbhuanaithe eacnamaíoch, chultúrtha agus shóisialta Ghaeltacht Chonamara Theas.

Is í Gaeltacht na Gaillimhe an Ghaeltacht is mó sa tír, le 53,459 áitritheoir (Daonáireamh 2022) – ionann agus 51% de dhaonra iomlán na Gaeltachta ar fud na tíre. Tacaíonn Údarás na Gaeltachta faoi láthair le 302 cliant-chuideachta i nGaeltacht Chonamara Theas amháin, a chuireann 2,863 post lánaimseartha ar fáil. Cuireann ár 20 comhlacht is mó 2,260 de na poist seo ar fáil, rud a léiríonn a thábhachtaí is atá siad mar ancairí eacnamaíocha don réigiún.

In 2024, bhain ár gcliantchomhlachtaí ar fud na Gaeltachta díolacháin de €1.098 milliún amach – méadú 4.4% ó 2023 agus fás 28% thar an deich mbliana anuas. Baineadh amach díolacháin easpórtála de €658 milliún, rud a léiríonn scóip idirnáisiúnta agus acmhainneacht na bhfiontar seo. Mar sin féin, in ainneoin an fheidhmíochta shuntasáigh seo, tá ár gcliantchomhlachtaí i gConamara Theas ag feidhmiú faoi mhíbhuntáiste de bharr easnaimh infreastruchtúir.

Níl an staid reatha inbhuanaithe:

- Tá Droichead na gCúig Céad, an t-aon mhór-dhroichead iompair trasna na Coiribe, i bhfad thar a acmhainn deartha
- Bíonn moilleanna leanúnacha ar thrácht, rud a chuireann isteach ar oibriochtaí gnó
- Tá amanna aistir idir an taobh thoir de Ghaillimh agus Conamara Theas ró-fhada agus
- Chuir dúnadh Aerfort na Gaillimhe i mí Dheireadh Fómhair 2011 le heaspa rochtain chuig an réigiún
- Tá rochtain ar chalafort Ros an Mhíl, láthair farraige ríthábhachtach, srianta go mór

Is bagairt d'fhorbairt inbhuanaithe an réigiún Ghaeltachta iad na heasnaimh bonneagair seo faoin tráth seo.

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Ríaltas na hÉireann

Dhéanfadh forbairt an Chuarbhóthair N6 buntáistí straitéiseacha iomadúla a sheachadadh:

1. Iomaíochas Gnó Feabhsaithe

- Rochtaín fheabhsaithe ar mhargaí náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta do tháirgí onnmhairithe
- Slabhraí soláthair níos éifeachtaí do amhábhair agus earrai críochnaithe
- Naisc níos fearr le calafoirt, aerfoirt, agus an gréasán mótarbhealaí náisiúnta
- Margadh saothair leathnaithe, go háirithe do scileanna speisialaithe atá ar fáil i nGaillimh thoir
- Deiseanna nua do chomhoibriú gnó ar fud an réigiúin

2. Nuálaíocht agus Dul Chun Cinn Teicneolaíochta

- Tacaíocht do chomhlacthaí ardteicneolaíochta ar nós Mylan, Freudenberg Medical, Aran Biomedical, ÉireComposites, agus Telegael
- Inmharthanacht fheabhsaithe dár gcuideachtaí a bhfuil gradaim buaite acu a fuair tacaíocht ón gCiste Nuálaíochta um Theicneolaíochtaí Bunathraitheacha
- Fás luathaithe ar ár ngréasán mol digiteach gteic, a chothaíonn nuálaíocht, cruthaitheacht, agus cumas cianoibre

3. Forbairt Gheilleagar na Mara

- Tacaíocht bhonneagair ríthábhachtach do Pháirc na Mara i gCill Chiaráin (70km siar ó chathair na Gaillimhe)
- Nascacht fheabhsaithe do sheirbhísí nuálaíochta mara agus gnólachtaí
- Rochtaín fheabhsaithe ar an gcalafort straitéiseach ag Ros an Mhíl
- Tacaíocht d'fhás inbhuanaithe san dohtarshaothrú, biteicneolaíochta mhara, agus fuinneamh mara

4. Fás Turasóireachta

- Rochtaín fheabhsaithe do na 200,000+ cuairteoir bliantúil ar Chonamara agus Árainn
- Tacaíocht do thionscnaimh Chósta Gaelaigh Chonamara agus Árann
- Scaipeadh feabhsaithe cuairteoirí ar fud iarthaí Chontae na Gaillimhe
- Laghdú ar phlódú tráchta a chuireann turasóirí ó chuairt a thabhairt faoi láthair

5. Buntáistí Comhshaoil agus Inbhuanaitheachta

- Seirbhísí iompair phoiblí leathnaithe a chumasú go Conamara Theas
- Astaíochtaí carbón laghdaithe trí phlódú laghdaithe agus patrúin aistir níos éifeachtaí
- Tacú le coinneáil an daonra i bpobail Ghaeltachta

- Líonraí sóisialta agus cultúrtha a chaomhnú a thacaíonn leis an nGaeilge

Mar eagraíocht a bhfuil sainordú aici an Ghaeilge a neartú agus a chaomhnú mar phríomhmheán cumarsáide i bpobail Ghaeltachta, aithníonn muid nach féidir beocht eacnamaíoch a scaradh ó inbhuanaitheacht chultúrtha. Léiríonn ár dtáighde go labhraíonn 58% díobh siúd atá fostaithe i gcliant-chuideachtaí Údarás Gaeilge, agus tá úsáid na teanga san earnáil na meán an-láidir ar fad.

Níl infreastreachtúr iompair amháin é Cuarbhóthar an N6 – is líne saoil é a chuirfidh ar chumas phobail na Gaeltachta rath eacnamaíoch a bhaint amach agus a bhféiniúlacht chultúrtha shainiúil a choinneáil sa 21ú haois.

Is éard atá sa Chuarbhóthar N6 ná bonneagar riachtanach a chuirfeadh go bunúsach le hinmharthanacht agus tarraingteacht réigiún na Gaeltachta ó thaobh infheistíocha, fostáiochta, turasóireachta, agus cálíochta na beatha de. Tar éis anailís chúramach a dhéanamh ar a thionchair, táimid den tuairim láidir, mheáite nach bhfuil i bhforbairt an chuarbhóthair seo díreach tairbheach ach riachtanach do thodhchaí inbhuanaithe na Gaeltachta.
