1. I gcomhreoir le hait 51(2) d'Acht na mBoithre, 1993, arna leusu, rinne Comhairle Chontae na Mi ("udaras na mbóithre") iarratas chuig an mBord Pleanaala ('an Bord') ar an 6 Nollaig 2023 lena cheadu maidir le forbairt bothair bheartaithe a bhfuil a teideal thus.
2. Cuirteadh Tuarascall ar Mheasunacht Tionchair Timpeallacha (ETAR) arna ullimh Natura (NIS) faol bhraid an Bhoird mar chuid den iarratas sin.
3. Thaisc an t-iarratasoir freagra fáinsneise breise tais an mBord Pleanaala an 16 Nollaig 2024. Measann an Bord (i gcomhreoir le hait 51(4A) d'Acht na mBoithre, 1993, arna leusu) go bhfuil sonraf breise suntasacha san fháinsneis bhreise sin i ndail le helseachtaf na forbartha bothair bheartaithe ar an gcomhshaoil.
4. Is feidir coip den fhreagra le fáinsneis bhreise, mar aon le doiciméadacht an iarratais bhunaidh, Tuarascall ar Mheasunacht Tionchair Timpeallacha (ETAR) agus Raiteas Tionchair Natura (NIS) a iniuchadh saor in aisce no iad a cheannach ach taille shonraithe.
5. Is feidir aighneachtatf no barulacha i ndail le híarratas EIAR/ NIS. ag a foe (nach mbeidh nfos mo na an costas reasunach a bhaineann le coip a dheanamh) ag an lathair liostaítear thíos ar laethanta oibre idir **9am agus 1pm agus 2pm agus 5pm** idir an **4 Feabhrá 2025 agus an 18 Marta 2025**.
6. Is feidir aighneachtatf no barulacha i ndail leis an bhfreagairt fáinsneise breise a dheanamh i scríbhinn chuíg an mBord (feach thíos), idir an **4 Feabhrá 2025 agus 5.30pm an 18 Marta 2025**. Ta taille €50 ar aighneacht/ barul a dheanamh i ndail le híarratas EIAR/ NIS. Nf bhaineann an taille le comhlachtaí forordaithe airithe na le huineif readmhainne agus daidíne éile a bhfuil leas dlíthiúil acu i dtalamh, ata ag cur i gcoinne fhaill eigeantach na talún a bhfuil leas den sort sin acu inti i geas um fhail eigeantach.

- Is feidir le duine ballfocht aon chinidh a rinne an Bord Pleanaala maidir le forbairt bothair bheartaithe a cheistíu ach iarratas a chur isteach le haghaidh athbhreithniu nUaschuitreanna atá in I.R. 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1. In accordance with section 51(2) of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (which shall not exceed the reasonable cost of making a copy) at the location listed below on working days between the hours of **9am to 1pm and 2pm to 5pm between the 4 February 2025 and 18 March 2025**.
2. An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) prepared in accordance with section 50 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) were submitted to the Board as part of this application.
3. An additional information response was lodged by the applicant with An Bord Pleanaala on the 16 December 2024. The Board considers (in accordance with section 51(4A) of the Roads Act 1993, as amended) that this additional information contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed road development.
4. A copy of the additional information response, together with the original application documentation, Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and Natura Impact Statement (NIS) may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (which shall not exceed the reasonable cost of making a copy) at the location listed below on working days between the hours of **9am to 1pm and 2pm to 5pm between the 4 February 2025 and 18 March 2025**.
5. The documentation may also be inspected and downloaded free of charge at the website: www.n2slaneby.1.ass.ie
6. Submissions or observations in relation to the additional information response may be made in writing to the Board (see below), between the 4 February 2025 and 5.30pm on the 18 March 2025.
- There is a €50 fee for making a submission/observation in relation to the EIAR/ NIS Application.
- This fee does not apply to certain prescribed bodies or to property owners and others with a legal interest in land who are objecting to compulsory acquisition of land in which they have such an interest in a compulsory acquisition case.
- There is no fee required to make a submission for those parties/individuals who have already made a valid written submission to the Board regarding the application.
- Submissions with a fee (if applicable) can be made via post (to: **An Bord Pleanaala at 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, D01 V902**), in person, and via the Board's on line submission portal <http://1s://online.1.leanala.ie/en-ie/sid/observationObservationsQleanala.ie>

- 7-The Board, in relation to an application for approval under section 51 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, having reached a reasoned conclusion under section 51(5) (c) and being satisfied that the reasoned conclusion remains up-to-date, may, by order, approve the proposed road development, with or without modifications and subject to whatever environmental conditions (including conditions regarding monitoring measures, parameters to be monitored and the duration of monitoring) it considers appropriate, or may refuse to approve such development.
- A person may question the validity of any decision by An Bord Pleanaala on a proposed road development by way of an application for judicial review under the Rules of the Superior Courts (and in particular Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts contained in S.I No. 15 of 1986 as amended) and in accordance with sections 50, SOA and SOB of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.
