I'm an 18 year old student who has holidayed in Brittas Bay all my life with my family/friends and I find it the most beautiful relaxing and fun place to be. I want it to remain like this for my future family.

I submitted my original observation in August 2024 requesting that ABP refuse the planning application to SSE Renewables mainly because it's being proposed in the wrong location and the choice of site for a wind farm is completely unrealistic.

I am annoyed that ABP had to request 56 pages for additional information from SSE when I innocently and naturally understood that their original EIA would have been professional and adequate enough to present it to planning. Obviously not??? Nothing in their additional information convinces me that this wind farm should go ahead on the Arklow Bank.

There has to be an other site more suitable for renewable wind energy to the east of the sandbank. Look at the one proposed by Source Galileo for their Mac Lir project, out 22kms from shore and it's just south of the Arklow Bank.
