OBSERVATION ON ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am a local resident with a long connection to and love of Brittas Bay and the Wiclow coast, I previously made an observation on this application because I am concerned that a very large industrial development is proposed on a shallow and dynamic offshore sandbank close to beaches, dunes, protected habitats and coastal communities.

This observation concerns the additional information submitted by Sure Partners Limited.

Brittas Bay is my local beach and I swim/walk there daily between April and November, and visit regularly over the cooler months. I work from home (near Jack Whites pub) in the healing/holistic area, and frequently use the beach as a source of connection with nature, and a perfect place for mindfulness. It is abhorrent to think that the concerns I highlighted in my submission about this case have not been addressed.

I therefore request that ACP refuse permission, or require further independent assessment, unless and until SSE provides scientifically robust evidence demonstrating that the project will not adversely affect Arklow Bank, coastal processes, water quality, protected habitats, wildlife or the integrity of the adjoining Wicklow and Wexford coastlines.
