

We refer to the above matter and are writing to you as concerned residents regarding the above application. We set out hereunder a list of our objections to this project

1. This is a green area used and always has been used by the Children of Ayrfield and if this is taken away from them we are left with no area for them to play on.
2. Our Children will not be safe and to have an opening onto a Main Road, (dual carriageway) would be a recipe for disaster and only waiting for a child or adult to be killed or seriously injured .
3. It also makes it easier for a quick getaway either from Ayrfield Drive or from the Malahide Road into Ayrfield Drive and through the other estates for undesirables.
4. It will leave the residents very vulnerable to all sorts of antisocial behaviour
5. It will also cause parking problems as people who are accessing the bus stop on the Malahide Road, will drive into Ayrfield walk through and this will cause more problems for us Residents, who bought our houses some 40 years ago because we wanted a safe place to live. If this proceeds we are no longer safe in our homes and this is not right.

Please refuse this application for the safety and wellbeing of our children and residents who live in Ayfield.
