

The National Transport Authority has made an application to An Bord Pleanála for a CPO in respect of a site at 45–47 Ayrfield Drive, Dublin 13, as part of the Bus Connects plan (please see attached notice).

Residents from Ard Na Greine are strongly opposed to this proposal and I am fully supporting them in this regard on the following grounds.

- Security and overall safety of the area
- Increase in anti-social behaviour
- Children, and residents, losing the use of a green space. Constantly in use by children when they are not in school.
- Direct access to dual carriageway for children who are used to playing outdoors in a safe, secure residential area. The child safety implication here is huge for the area.
- Strong probability of change in our low crime area to an area of high crime as it is easier to abscond from Gardai
- Increase in cars parking for people wanting to use the bus connect service
- Increased noise pollution the current wall acts as a sound barrier from the busy dual carriageway.
