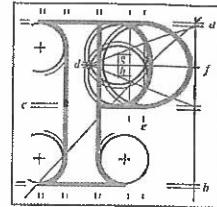

To whom it may concern.

We wish to submit an objection to the present plans for the following reasons -

Our property will now be closer to the main road & footpath & liable to further onslaught of foreign missiles such as beer bottles, beer cans, broken glass etc etc being dumped in our drive putting our vehicles liable to even further damage.

To protect our home & vehicles it will be necessary to have gates 2 metres high, fitted and fence fitted to perimeter walls.

A more serious problem will occur when we leave our property by car & will have to park our car on bus/cycle lane, turn off engine, lock car & return to close our gates **THINK ABOUT THAT FOR A MINUTE, ABSOLUTE CHAOS.**

A solution is for you to fit all homes with electronic gates, convex mirrors to ensure against serious accidents and that traffic will flow freely.

It is imperative that Residents of Maypark be permitted to use Bus Lane coming down Malahide Road. It is not uncommon to see 4/5 buses in line, 20/30 taxis up to 300 yards long owing to traffic lights. Cameras can be used to insure against misuse of bus lane, otherwise this wont work, it cant work.
