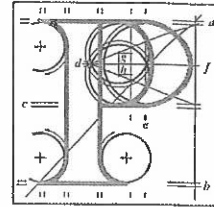

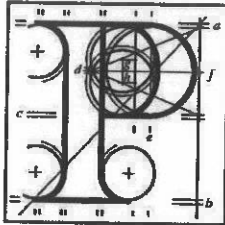

The following are my reasons and arguments in support of this application:

1. Safer road for everyone, especially for children, vulnerable pedestrians and mobility aid users and cyclists
2. Changes to road design to deter traffic encourages pedestrian and cycle movement and promotes a better sense of community
3. Eradication of rat-running traffic through Haverty Road, Carlton Road and Brian Road (50-60 motor vehicles and motorbikes travelling at speed at peak times)
4. There are currently 17 children under the age of 12 on Haverty Road.
5. The road is used every day by school children coming and going from St Joseph's primary and secondary school.
6. There is ample room at the junction of Haverty Road/St Aiden's Park Road at the proposed location for a turnaround area for motorists, emergency services and other services that are currently challenged by the number of cars and vans parked on corners.  
There are already several roads in Marino where this works successfully.
