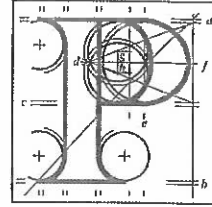

You will be notified of the arrangements for the opening of any such oral hearing. The holding of any oral hearing is at the discretion of the Board.


