As a co-owner and resident of 110 Pembroke Road I wish to object on the strongest possible terms to the bus corridor plans for Pembroke Road and Baggot Street.

The area would be destroyed by proposed alterations to the streetscape. Baggot Street is a vibrant destination for shopping and entertainment. This would make the area dead and most certainly lead to closures of business and ruin the area for industry and community. Dublin 4 is very much residential, making Dublin city more residential should be a planning objective for an Bord Pleanala. Getting people, a mile up the road to shopping destinations is hardly relevant.
