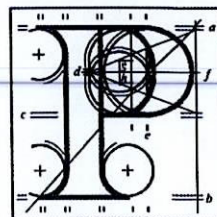

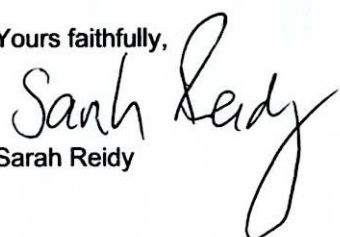

**Re: BusConnects Dublin Core Bus Corridor – Route 14 (Belfield / Blackrock to City Centre'
Core Bus Corridor (CBC) Scheme
UCD Ballsbridge to City Centre Section
Route Option PR4**

I wish to point out a number of objections that I have with the above proposals, as follows

- Any proposal to stop traffic turning right from Mespil Road on to Upper Baggot Street will be severely detrimental to the local businesses on Upper Baggot Street;
- A situation where there is no through traffic from Upper Baggot Street to Pembroke Road will cut what is an existing vibrant community in two;
- It is ridiculous that there will be no / restricted parking in the Upper Baggot Street area – on street loading and parking are essential for this area;
- Turning a Georgian and Victorian streetscape into a bus corridor is vandalism at its most extreme;
- Cycle lanes on Haddington Road is a nonsense- when they are already running along the Canal;
- Cutting off access from Eastmoreland Place / St Mary's Road on to Upper Baggot Street further divides the community, and is illogical;
- Sending buses up Pembroke Road, cutting off car access from Ballsbridge/Jurys and Baggot Street, will cripple the local businesses in the Upper Baggot Street area; and
- Stopping parking on the Upper Baggot Street, will as a consequence push car demand to Waterloo Road, where there is already restricted parking Monday through to Saturday with the "priority" bus lane, and where there is inadequate parking available for residents and their visitors – local residents / businesses are being penalised unfairly.
