

With a view of continued commitment to improve taxi industry, and the quest to provide PFA increasing membership the enabling supports deemed necessary for their business, we outline our concerns.

Our submission and Observation are thus as follows:

PFA and her members certainly appreciate the key importance of the bus connects scheme and its affiliation with the national policy within the Project Ireland National Development Plan 2021-2030.

However, looking at the hardcopy of the proposed public transports and cycling / pedestrian's lane of 6.7 kilometres east-west corridor through the city centre we observed an area of concern for the existing taxi rank at Eyre Square, Galway. The diagrams available identify that the current taxi rank will be axed during and after the road project.

Therefore, we stand unanimously to object the likely removal of the taxi rank in Eyre Square.

The Central Part of our business is in the Square; its location is accessible and attracts commuters from all parts of the city, county, including tourist and students.

We extend our objection to An Bord Pleanála, Galway Transport Strategy (GTS), Galway City Council Executive, National Transport Authority (NTA), if the road route project will similarly alter the taxi rank in Eyre Square, Galway.

Thanking you in-anticipation of a reversal and amendment to the route to accommodate the smoot running of our taxi business.

Please find the attached signatories from members of Taxi group in Galway opposing the proposal to remove Eyre Taxi Rank from its current position.
