

Ref: Ballymun/Finglas to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme. Regarding the proposal for the Mobi Rd/Ballymun Rerouting to Ballygall?

The proposal is that Mobi road becomes a one-way system at rush hour. And that from the met office to Mobi and Griffith Road a permanent barrier. This road has been used for hundreds of years and should not have the right of way and public use removed so casually. Traffic going through Ballymun will now have to reroute through the old Finglas road, Ballygall Road or Tolka estate. This will place a heavy burden in our area which is mostly residential with many schools. The obvious route is Ballymun and not to close the Ballymun road.

This proposal if goes ahead is divisive. We are looking for a fair solution. Yet residents have not been consulted until only recently.

The insistence of retention of trees on Mobi road needs to be looked at as this re-routing to Ballygall is compounding traffic problem from one area and shifting it to another. And will affect the residents greatly. As residents of Tolka Estate we feel it is unfair to be burdened with heavy traffic coming from both Mobi road and Ballymun road. affecting our mostly elderly population, plus many young mothers with family's and the surrounding seven schools, plus creches, older persons services and will affect the quality of life of hundreds of houses within this area.

Serious consideration needs to be given before the disruption to our thousands of residents. We need a more purposeful and solution focused approach serves this community, and while public transport is necessary this plan is meant to serve communities and not make suburban estates a casualty. I have over 40 signatures of Tolka estate residents who do not want this disruption in their community, and there are many more...
