

To whom it may concern,

Glasilawn Environmental Group wish to make the following observations on the statutory planning listed above. We as agroup are in favour of better, more efficient public transport and cycling options but diverting all traffic into one single road (Cremore Villas) Ballygall Road that already services a number of schools in the area and already has major traffic problems is a non runner.

## COMMUNICATION,

We understand that several meetings have taken place and some of the meetings were over zoom during covid, which didn't suit members of our community group, therefore our community does not feel there has been adequate engagement with us regarding this process.

### ENVIORONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT.

The environmental impact assessment does not adequately address the impact to Ballygall Road East or the side estates of Glasilawn Road and Avenue Glasmeen Glasnamana Tolka Estate and Griffith Road. Also more traffic will be forced along Old Finglas Road to take Tolka Estate Road turn. Due to the proposed closure of Ballymun Road Lower and Mobhi Road northbound all traffic will be diverted to the above areas, many of these are not in a position to take on heavy volumes of traffic. All residential areas, many which are already suffering due to narrow roadways with residents all ready under pressure to park or get access to their homes due to traffic problems. We would expect to see any assessment which has been carried out to see the impact from noise, environmental pollution

# LOWER BALLYMUN ROAD CLOSURE MODIFIED VERSION OF A

The plan to close Ballymun Road to traffic is a complete disaster as it makes no sense to divert traffic away from shortest route possible to take traffic away from city suburbs ,,the quickest way to bring traffic onward to the M50 .
