

Subject: 1002(7).2f - Objection to temporary land acquisition, Recreational Dublin Green Area at Rafters Road, Crumlin, Dublin 12

To Whom it May Concern,

We, the residents of 347 Crumlin Road, Crumlin strongly object to the compulsory purchase of the recreational space and green area at Rafters Road, Crumlin, Dublin 12. We have set out the reasons for our objection below:

- The green area is a popular, well used to space by our family and other residents in the area.
 The loss of access to this recreational area will have a negative impact on the local community as it essentially removes a very practical local amenity.
- The mature trees and green space together provide a very pleasant space to local residents which will not be reinstated to their former appearance once the project is completed.
- The green area and mature trees help to offset traffic emissions. When the trees are
 removed, this will compound the already poor air quality level as a result of the vehicular
 traffic. This considerable environmental issue must be considered given any trees that will be
 planted post-construction will not offset the vehicular emissions to the same degree as preconstruction.
- The loss of this green space and recreational area will negatively impact local property prices and coupled with the ongoing construction, any local residents why may wish to move will be hugely impacted by this loss of value
- Currently, it is not obvious that Bus Connects will bring any meaningful positive change to
 the Crumlin area as the proposed plan significantly widens the road but does not help to
 reduce traffic volume. The Rafters Road green area would be better utilised as a Dublin Bike
 depot to promote the use of non-motor vehicles in the area.

We hope you take our objections into consideration and review the proposed plan for this important recreational and green area for local residents.
