Submissions on behalf of Michelle and John-Paul Lyons of 7 Birchview Avenue

Reference the proposed introduction of a tow-lane Bus link, bus route and cycle lane, off the Greenhills Road and through the residential developments in the cul de sac at Birchview Avenue, in front of the existing homes. Ref: General Arrangement sheet numbers 10 of 56 and 11 of 56.

We, the homeowner of 7 Birchview Avenue are 17 years living on this road, our home is 50 years old this year, our 3 children are growing up fast and the green space area is really important to them and us. This is the only greenspace this side of Kilnamanagh, my children can play safely here. It is very evident that this space is widely used with goalposts and footballs in this area. This is an essential recreational space to each house in the Birchview area.

The greenspace area was recently upgraded with footpaths and led lampposts which we were along time waiting for and now this will all be all undone. If this greenspace is cut off from the residents we won't have access to Tymon park, we will have to cross 3 roads now to access the park. It will also cut off access to children attending local schools in the area like Collaiste de Hide, St Kevins BNS & GNS and Scoil losa.

We feel very strongly that all this upheaval to our greenspace is for 2 buses, 1 going up the Tymon North and 1 going up to Tallaght Village, if will not benefit the bus service in anyway as buses will be going back into a single lane of traffic

Another concern is the noise pollution that will bring to the residents of Birchview Avenue and Parkview, with buses running closer to our homes. With proposed bus stops at the side of no. 18 Birchview Avenue, this could potentially bring anti-social behaviour.
