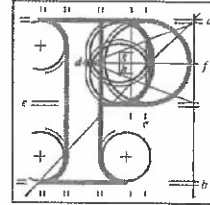

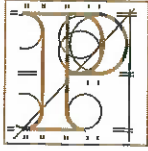

MOTION: Councillor C. O'Connor

"That this Tallaght Area Committee calls on the CEO to furnish a report on the submission he is making before the 4th of July in respect of Bus Connects proposals seriously affecting communities in Bancroft, Kilnamanagh and Springfield; will he understand the upset and concerns being expressed and will he make a statement for discussion?"

REPORT:

South Dublin County Council will be making a multidisciplinary submission to an Bord Pleanála in relation to the Tallaght and Clondalkin to City Centre Core Bus corridor planning application.

The submission will be made as part of the Statutory public consultation which runs up until the 4th July 2023.

Several departments from SDCC will make contributions on matters affecting their services. The Traffic and Transportation section will be making a contribution in relation to traffic and access items.

The final draft of the combined submission will be signed off by each Director of Service before the official response is submitted.

When this final draft is complete and signed off, I can make a copy of this report available to members.

I do understand the upset caused by this major scheme to residents in the Bancroft, Kilnamanagh and Springfield areas. I have made these concerns known to the NTA at earlier stages of this process and some

adjustments have been made as a result, such as the minimisation of land take and improvements in permeability where possible.

The process has involved several non-statutory consultations to date where members of the public could make their views known. I am sure these submissions were considered carefully.
