I wish to make an observation and submission to object to the proposed planning on the grounds that I have tubary rights at Derryshannoge, Derraghan and have been cutting turf and using my tubary rights for over fifty years.

The proposed application ref No:P0504 will interfere with my tubary rights.

The primary fuel source for our home has been turf since the establishment and allocation of Tubary with BnM. Our home is heavily dependent on this fuel source. Any change from this rural culture practise will have a significant impact to home heating retrofits, fuel costs in terms of oil / gas / or renewable technologies (none of which has been considered by BnM's application for substitute Consent as per the reference on this letter)
