Dear Sir,

I refer to the Projects of Common Interest permit granting and public participation process and the application lodged by Greenlink Interconnector Limited of 70 Sir Rogerson's Quay, Dublin 2 in December, 2020 under Article 10 of Regulation (EU) number 347/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17th April 2013 on guidelines for trans-European energy infrastructure in relation to the Greenlink Project (Reference Number PCI 1.9.1).

You will be aware that Ireland to implement the permit granting process has chosen the collaborative scheme as the mechanism to facilitate the issuing of the comprehensive decision.

granted authorisation to build the energy infrastructure to realise a project without prejudice to any decision taken in the context of an administrative appeal procedure.

An Bord Pleanála acting in its capacity as the designated Competent Authority for Projects of Common Interest in Ireland has co-ordinated the comprehensive decision.

Due account has been taken in the comprehensive decision of the results of activities related to the participation of the public prior to the submission of the application file, including those activities that took place before the start of the permit granting process, summarised in the Article 9.4 report submitted by you.

The decisions issued by the relevant authorities and identified as necessary by the project promotor to build the energy infrastructure to realise the project are listed in Appendix 1 attached to this letter. The comprehensive decision is now issued in accordance with Article 8(3)(c) of Regulation (EU) number 347/2013.

As Competent Authority we point out that the comprehensive decision in relation to the above project was issued in compliance with the time limits set out in Article 10.2 of the Regulation.
