Dear Sir/Madam,

Please accept this submission in respect of the above-referenced further development of a Quarry in Windmillhill, Rathcoole, Co. Dublin.

Irish Water (IW) has reviewed the plans and particulars of the development proposal and makes the following observations:

Irish Water notes the proposed development works are located in close proximity to existing IW asset(s) which include strategic **1600mm and 1270mm** concrete trunk mains. The proposed development works include blasting which gives rise to vibrations and other related activities have the potential to significantly impact critical public infrastructure and other Irish Water assets in the area.

To ensure appropriate protection and maintenance of public infrastructure and to ensure adequate provision of water and wastewater facilities, Irish Water respectfully requests any grant of substitute consent be conditioned as follows;

- 1. Prior to any works commencing the applicants/operators shall engage with Irish Water to agree construction/works
- 2. Prior to any blasting commencing the applicants/operators shall engage with Irish Water to agree construction/works
- 3 The applicant shall ensure no deterioration in the water quality and treatability of any IW drinking water sources, abstraction point(s) and/or watercourses in the area having connectivity with IW drinking water sources, arising from any preconstruction, construction or post construction, blasting. Works and/or operational, post operational activities
- 4 The applicant shall ensure that any and all surface/ground water source(s) within proximity to the proposed site are protected from any possible pollution

via surface and/or ground and/or hydrological pathways, connecting the development to water source(s)

- 5 The applicant shall ensure that there will be no negative impact to any of Irish Waters Groundwater Source(s) which may be in proximity to the development during both construction and operational phases of the development to ensure compliance with the Groundwater Directive (80/68/EEC).
- Irish Water does not permit any build over of its assets and separation distances as per Irish Waters Standards Codes and Practices must be achieved. Where any proposals by the applicant to build over or divert existing water or wastewater services subsequently occurs the applicant shall submit details to Irish Water for assessment of feasibility and have written confirmation of feasibility of diversion(s) from Irish Water
