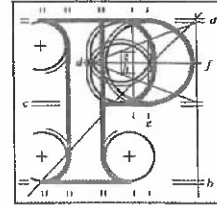

Dear Sir or Madam,

I have already made a submission on this matter to An Bord Pleanála, within the past year or so. However, I am making a fresh submission but my objection to this proposed scheme seems total, I seem to recall a major construction project in Ireland being postponed, or cancelled because it threatened the well-being of some snails, I consider my family and my neighbours well-being at least on a par with the humble snail. I read in the newspapers that the E.U. are going all out to re-naturalise our continent. Their plan for the urban section is to create more green space and plant more trees with this bus corridor I shall lose a beautiful mature tree a hedgerow in which blackbirds have nested for several years now, and 2 metres of grass which incidentally is green. But my main objection to this plan centers around my daughter Nicola who is disabled and confined to a wheelchair among a myriad of other problems she has

Nicola attends the C.R.C. every weekday Monday to Friday. This gives some structure & purpose to her life a mini bus calls at my gate each morning to load her and bring her to the C.R.C. and returns and unloads her each evening. How in Gods name will this continue with the bus corridor and monstrous buses flying by. Another point of contention is the post tunnel closes one night per week, and every lorry & trailer leaving Dublin port uses the Malahide Rd to access the M. 50. With the bus corridor the lorries will now have two lanes to travel in, once the buses finish for the night, consider the noise pollution, air pollution and stress this extra traffic will cause to the residents of the Malahide Rd. I trust that some of the points I have raised will be considered when arriving at your decision
