

To whom it may concern,

- I, Peadar Smyth, owner of Four Star Pizza Bray wish to make a submission re the proposed bus corridor by NTA through Castle Street, Bray, Co.Wicklow for the following reasons:
 - 1. You state that there are two designated loading bays northbound on Castle St.. There is no marked Loading bay opp the Castle St Centre.. It states clearly it's a bus lane...
 - 2. The 15 commercial spaces you refer to are serviceing a takeaway, Laundrette, Tax consultant, Men's clothing, ladies clothing and Tyre Centre...and sometimes used by residents of above appartments you propose to reduce to 4.. and considered to be a moderate negative impact.. on what basis have you come to this decision...???
 - 3. The side streets, you come to the conclusion have car parking facility of 215 spaces..have you counted how many private residents and businesses use these spaces and how many are available for overflo parking? From this I have come to the conclusion you haven't visited the said area at all and make your findings from google maps...these roads are already congested with residents parking..
 - 4. You propose to take whole car pk for 12 months.. When this starts will this be in writing or who will be held responsible for late delivery of proposed scheme? As the record in this country of these schemes being finished on time is abysmal ...so picking a proposed time in my opinion is to get it over the line... no one takes responsibility after that.
 - 5. You state that details regarding temporary parking spaces will be discussed with businness owners prior to construction... I have requested a meeting now with the CPO now and no one is available to talk.. Do it now and not when diggers are on site...
 - 6. You state parking will be available behind the Centre... Im actually so concerned as to how much research you have done here.. the spaces out the back are for residents above stores and also a car valeting company who own 3 units.. You lack of actual research is actually quite worrying..
 - 7. I look forward to going in search with you and go to the side streets and we can tell the residents and business owners you propose to use their spaces for car parking for Dargle Centre...

In conclusion the total lack of thought re local business is mind boggling If it wasn't so serious... you state that the new road will make people walk, bus and bike into Bray.. so by

your own admission you will practically close my business as for the 27 years I have been there I don't see many customers on a bike or a bus to collect a pizza...or get a tyre fixed.. so in theory you need to do a CPO on my business as well.. There's a human element here which you don't seen to care about.. and I would also like to repeat I would question if you have actually visited the area and done a proper investigation or was it done totally from Google maps?
