

THANK YOU FOR THE OPPORTUNITY OF APPEAL.

BRG IS DISMAYED AT THE LACK OF AN ORAL HEARING

WE HAVE BEEN CANVASSINGOPININION AND IDEAS SINCE MARCH HAVING REGARD TO THE EXTRA TRAFFIC ANTICIPATED WITH THE INCIPIENT TOWN AND CENTRE S/C AND THE FOUR OR FIVE MAJOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS ABUILDING. WITH THREE. OF THESE BEING ON THE OLD DUBLIN ROAD BRAYIS A DESIGNATED METROPOLITAN GROWTH TOWN AND BRAY MUNICIPAL DISTRICT (BRAY, ENNISKERRY AND,

KILMACANOGUE)) IS FORECAST TO EXCEED A POP. OF 50000 BY 2034 -- A SMALL CITY IN EU TERMS AND POSITIONED FOR ALL MANNER OF EU FUNDING

BRAY IS VERY HEAVILY CONGESTED: MORNING, MIDDAY, AND EVENING.

APPROX. EIGIT HOURS IN ALL AND COSTINGABOUT TWO MILLION EURO P.A , (DUBLIN 336 MILLION EURO P.A.)

BRG DISAGREES WITH THE PROPOSED SIGNALISING OF THE WILFORD R/A, ANY AND ALL CONGESTION IS CAUSED BY THE POOR LAYOUT AT OLD CONNA INTERSECTION; THE BADLY LOCATED BUS HALF PLAYING NO SMALL PART IN THE BACKING UP TO WILFORD R/A.

BRG ENVISAGE TWO NEW BRIDGES AND THE MODIFICATION OF THE DARGLE RIVER BRIDGE (1856)

BRIDGE NUMBER ONE

AT OR NEAR THE HARBOUR AREA OVER THE DARGLE RIVER TO SERVICE A NEW PUBLIC TRANSPORT HUB ON THE COMBINED C.I.E. SIDINGS AND THE CARLISLE GROUNDS PLAYING PITCH (ACRES) AREA. THIS HUB COULD PROVIDE : A DEDICATED MAINLINE

TWO DART LINES TWO LUAS LINES

SET DOWNS, TAXI AREAS, CHARGING POINTS, CYCLE BAYS, ETC, ETC. ETC. BRIDGE NUMBER TWO-

3 SCENARIOS WITH LUAS IF AND WHEN:

LUAS PROCEEDS ACROSS THE STATION PLAZA, UP FLORENCE ROAD TO WITHIN 80 METERS OF THE MAIN STREET T JUNCTION .

LUAS PROCEEDS UP QUINSBORO ROAD TO THE EGLINTON ROAD ROAD, GALTRIM PARK ROAD AND Q ROAD INTERSECTION (DUNNES STORES) •

AS IN 2 ABOVE BUT PROCEEDS ACROSS GALERIM PARK ROAD AND STOPS METERS SHORT OF THE SEAPOINT ROAD T JUNCTION.

THERE IS POTENTIAL AT THIS POINT FOR A FOOTBRIDGE TO BE IN PLACE FACILITATING ALL OF LITTLE BRAY AND THE HUGE BALLYMORE SEA GARDENS DEVELOPMENT 1400 UNITS.

FINALLY ITS MAKES HUGE SENSE FOR THE LUAS TO BE EXTENDED BOTH TO BRAY AND THE NEW FASSAROE (NEW PARK AND RIDE ALMOST COMPLETE) A WORKABLE MODUS VIVENDI WOULD BE FOR EVERY SECOND LUAS FROM DUBLIN TO END IN BRAY OR FASSAROE

THE HUB COULD ACCOMODATE 400 TO 800 NEW HOUSING UNITS WITH THE EXISTING RAILWAY STATION ALSO ON PLAY WITH, OVER THE STATION DEVELOPMENT -- 400 to 800 HOUSING UNITS.




