

I have previously made a submission on the above SID-OBS-001302, case number:317742

My further observations are as follows:

The number of trees that have to removed in Shankill is much higher than stated in the report. There is no accommodation of land to allow for the replanting that has been promised.

No consideration has been made for some buses to travel on the M11. In particular, I am thinking of buses that do not stop in Shankill and are already full by the time that they get here.

There is no mention of the negative impact of four lanes of traffic and 2 cycle lanes going through Shankill on the fabric of the village and the effect it will have on the village. There are 3 primary schools in Shankill, significant effort has been put in to encourage children to walk to school. I cannot see a parent allowing a child to traverse 4 lanes of traffic to get to school. I have heard no discussion as to the noise pollution that will occur with the vehicular traffic going through the village.

It is my opinion that the NTA should address the need of the corridor from Loughlinstown to Wilford separately rather than the whole route.

An oral hearing have been allowed for consideration in the Bray corridor. This should also happen in Shankill.
