

I refer to my submission of 10 October 2023 to An Bord Pleanala, on behalf of myself, my wife Berna and neighbours Geraldine and Sean Darcy, in which we objected to the proposed NTA BusConnects proposal to instigate a community and environmental vandalisation surrounding the village of Shankill. We outlined clearly the reasons for our objections which have not been addressed in the NTA's Report despite their agreement to address local residents' concerns. A proposed alternative route alongside the M11 motorway between the Wilford Roundabout and Loughlinstown Roundabout was not considered sufficiently. While cycle lane infrastructure improvement is planned for the entire route, it is not evident for the section through Shankill Village.

The NTA's perception of community support for the project omits conditional support meaning certain community wishes are being ignored in the plan.

One of the main objections is the extensive removal and destruction of ancient mature trees that provide carbon friendly environmental benefit between Loughlinstown roundabout and Wilford roundabout. Promised replacement of trees will be near to impossible and impracticable. The resulting concrete desert will be unacceptable to Shankill Residents.

The stated acknowledged negative effects in the NTA report are concentrated within the above mentioned section. The main negative impact from creating four traffic lanes plus 2 cycle lanes through the pedestrian busy village of Shankill is completely ignored.

Prior to the construction of the N11 Dual Carriageway, the villages of Stillorgan, Cornelscourt and Cabinteely were bypassed to redirect commuter traffic away to preserve the community sense of those villages. Loughlinstown village at one time was a vibrant community and the N11 Dual Carriageway reduced it to a motorised thoroughfare. This is not what the community of Shankill want or expect for their village.

Please consider the above before granting unconditional authorisation to the NTA to proceed with their community destructive plan for a non-stop bus corridor.
