



I am writing to formally renew my object to the planning application referenced above.

While I am supportive of the bus corridor and the additional services it will provide for the communities in the areas impacted.

I do object to the specific planning referenced, to open up the boundary wall for pedestrian access to buses and as a general pedestrian access route in the Shanganagh Vale estate.

- -There already is ample access to the N11 from the main entrance and the walk to the bus stop from the main entrance is only 0.25miles.
- An additional entrance, as there was previously in the estate in the same proximity led to many problems and was permanently closed over 15 years ago as a result.
- To open the wall now will lead to potential anti-social behaviour, property damage and intimidation from people passing through. This was the experience in the past and this is what led to the closing of previous access.
- An opening of the wall in this proximity leading on to a busy motorway could also be used for a quick exit for burglary or other criminal acts and will make the estate less safe.
- -I have also safety concerns for smaller / younger children wandering out on to a very busy N11 which has a speed limit of 80km where drivers do not expect pedestrians. There are also a number of creche in the estate in close proximity to the proposed opening which make these even more dangerous.

The overall benefit for some residents only, who may have a shorter walk to/from the bus stop is far outweighed by the risk of anti- social behaviour, potentially other criminal acts and safety concerns.
