

Having make countless submissions, observations personally to NTA at forums, resident groups meeting NTA, online submissions etc I alarmed that the PERSONAL SECURITY of Shankill residents walking from the village and from the bus corridor to DART station, Dorney Court, Corbawn, Clanmyr and vice versa is still being ignored.

With the current and all past designs closing of Corbawn Lane NTA will create a dangerous unsupervised walking route for many walking to and from bus corridor and to and from dart station. As a mother of young adults and chairperson of Corbawn residents committee this concern has been raised continually. This is currently a busy section of road and currently the cars driving up & down provides a high level of PASSIVE security and reassurance. Rather than improving the public realm, as extensively advertised, Bus Connects will create a dangerous no go area late at night that will facilitate anti social behaviour and pose new risks for individuals moving between the Village, travel hubs and residential areas.

Rather than improving safety of young adults and encouraging use of public transport this will force families to ferry people around this NEW dangerous no go area and more worrying could lead to assaults and Anti social behaviour.

There are many other issues I could also draw attention to but as the above issue is so dangerous I don't want this PERSONAL SECURITY issue to be overlooked AGAIN.
