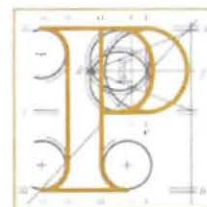

To Whom It May Concern:

Re: Leeson Street to Donnybrook (Anglesea Road Junction) (distance 2.1km)

I suggest that instead of the proposed plan there should be a two way cycle lane from:

Wellington Close along Pembroke Park (or through the west side of Herbert Park) and on through east Herbert Park to join the Dodder cycle way.

WHY

Further to my previous submission – I would like to add:

Cycle lanes that are off main roads are safer – always a preferred option and are therefore more used than those on main roads. They are safer. Preferred by parents sending children to school.

Being a bus corridor – the cycle lane is likely to be broken for bus stops – this causes yet another hazard and
