

## Kincora, Avonmore, Foxrock, D18RD90. 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

Observation Re: Proposed Bus Connects at Whites Cross (Junction of Leopardstown Road, N11 and Newtown Park Avenue).

I am alarmed at the suggestion/proposal that the motor vehicle slip lanes are to be removed. We live on the N11 (D18RD90) quite close to Whites Cross. During rush hours there is always a considerable back up of traffic in all four directions (Leopardstown Road, Newtown Park Avenue and N11 in both directions). Removing the slip lanes will only make that considerably worse.

I am a car driver (fully electric) and a regular cyclist through Whites Cross several times per day. There shall be no improvement to cyclists by such a change as there is no difficulty navigating the junction by bicycle. Cars using the slip lanes are always respectful of cyclists as they currently have a dedicated bicycle lane.

I'm also a regular pedestrian through the junction (I walk our 2 dogs daily) and have no issue crossing once I obey the lights. The only improvement I can see from this proposal would be for pedestrians to avoid having to cross the slip lanes, which, in my experience, is an extremely minor issue.

I understand the desire to reduce cars from the road and encourage cycling/walking and using public transport. But the reality is that cars are still here for some time to come. Older people and parents with small children or heavy shopping will need to use their car regardless of what other options are available. So this proposal shall heavily penalise car drivers for almost no gain. All that will happen is further backing up of traffic at this junction with engines ticking over causing extra pollution and further frustration to motorists for no benefit.
